In addition to the 328 hours, one of the following requirements must be met:

- A. 120 hours in an experience training module hands-on through Champions or with a licensed professional inspector (provide letter or course completion certificate from education provider, or letter of attendance from inspector); **or**
- B. Three years as an active licensed professional engineer, engineer-in-training or licensed/registered architect (provide a license history); **or**
- C. Five years personal experience in a field directly related to home inspecting (provide two reference letters from persons other than applicant with personal knowledge of applicant's work).

Submit your Application for an Inactive license and Educational Documents to the "My License" system.

Once you have completed your courses at Champions, you will now need to submit your education, experience and Professional Inspector License Application to TREC in the "My License" system on the Texas Real Estate Commission's website at www.trec.texas.gov. Click on "Register HERE to set up a user ID and password" and follow the steps to create an account. Once an account is created you will apply for a new license. The application fee for a Professional Inspector license is \$104.

If you have your education certificate and/or experience documentation, you will need to scan and send in your education documents along with a digital copy of the application electronically to education@trec.texas.gov. Or you may fax copies of them to 512-936-3863.

Upon receipt of Candidate Information Brochure (CIB), call PSI to schedule State Exam.

Pass State Exam within six months of filing application with TREC.

You must pass the exam with a 75% or higher score. The cost for the exam is \$61.

Note: If applicant does not pass exam after third attempt, he/she must wait six months from last fail date to reapply to take exam.

Upon passing State Exam, we recommend joining Champions Inspector Association (CIA) for continued mentoring and learning (Houston Campus Only).

6

Annually complete Inspector Continuing Education requirement.

Complete 16 hours each year for two-year renewal (must include 8 hours Standards of Practice Legal/Ethics) from Champions. Pay \$70 renewal fee to TREC.
